SUMMER PROGRAM FINANCIAL AID 2020

How do sliding scale fees at Sixth Street's Youth Program (SSYP) work?

Sixth Street Community Center is dedicated to making our youth programs (after school and summer) accessible to all children regardless of financial means. We strive to create a sliding scale programs fee structure that is accommodating and considerate of family households at all income levels.

We are a small non-profit that operates primarily through small private contributions and our programming fees. **Program fees are essential to SSYP's livelihood as well as it's ability to offer reduced fees to those who need it most.** We recognize that New York City is increasingly becoming less and less affordable; therefore we aim to make our programming as affordable as possible while still upholding the standards and quality of our programming.

If you would like to apply to receive reduced programming fees, our process is detailed below.

- Please indicate on the program application that you would like to apply for sliding scale fees. Return or send in the application with a \$100 program deposit. This deposit is required. It is non-refundable if your child is enrolled in our program and would count towards program fees.
- Complete the financial form at the end of this letter. **In order to to be considered, you must answer all questions and attach the first page of your most recent income tax return, proof of unemployment or disability.**

Here is a general guideline for how we may determine a sliding scale tuition rate:

| <u>Gross Family Income</u> | <u>Regular Day Rate (9-3)</u> | <u>Extended Day Rate (9-5)</u> |
|-----------------------------------|--------------------------------------|---------------------------------------|
| \$75,000 and up | \$450/week (full session only) | \$600/week |
| \$65-\$74,999 | \$405/week (\$1,215 per session) | \$545/week |
| \$55-\$64,999 | \$380/week (\$1,140 per session) | \$515/week |
| \$45-\$54,999 | \$350/week (\$1,050 per session) | \$475/week |
| \$35-\$44,999 | \$275/week (\$825 per session) | \$375/week |
| \$24,500-\$34,999 | \$200/week (\$600 per session) | \$275/week |
| \$24,499 and under | \$100/week (\$300 per session) | \$145/week |

Please consider these figures as guidelines. On average, at least 75% of our of students attend our program on sliding scale rates based on family income. We are able to offer assistance to a greater number students, only when financial needs are calculated accurately and honestly. We thank you for your interest in the Sixth Street Youth Program. We welcome your children and wish to accommodate your financial needs as best as we can. After we receive your financial aid form, we will get back to you with your financial aid award.
