I/We _____ understand that the benefits and risks of the growing season in these difficult economic times are shared by all and agree to the responsibilities that entail being a part of the Sixth Street Community Center Winter Share:

- **Payments** – Payment is due before your first pick-up. Installment plans are available if needed. Late registrations are accepted and your payment will be pro-rated from the date of your first pick-up. Call 212-677-1863 to arrange. (Please note that there are no refunds).
- **Committee Involvement** -- Members are required to participate in at least two [2.5 hr] committee shifts (5 hours total for the season) to fulfill your volunteer duties.

An email will be sent to all CSA members with a link to sign up for committee shifts. There you will be able to reserve volunteer dates and times that work for you.

Below are the various committees we offer (check one or more). Contact us w/ any questions!

- Site Management Committee** - This committee is an opportunity to get to know your fellow CSA members and engage with our neighbors! Two shift options: Set up, sign in members, distribute produce and handle inquiries (3:30-5:30pm), or sign in members, distribute produce, handle inquiries and break-down and clean up (5:30- 7:30pm).
- Outreach & Community Engagement Committee** - Share information about our CSA with others to increase visibility and enrollment of the Sixth Street CSA. Engage members of the broader community on our CSA, and how they too could participate in this sustainable food model that supports farmers and expands food access in our community. Other activities can look like organizing farm trips, potlucks, community cooking workshops, community education workshops and other supporting events.
- Fundraising Committee** - Help us fundraise to support our CSA and related Sixth Street Programs [SSCC's Emergency Food Distribution Program, Mutual Aid Kitchen Project, Teen Climate Justice Program & Climate Justice Organizing!]

3. Share Pick-ups and Absence– Pick-ups are every other Wednesday beginning January 4 2023 from 4pm–7pm at Sixth Street Community Center. If you are unable to pick up your share during these hours, please email us (by 12pm the day of pickup) and your share can be set aside for pick-up on the following day. *Please use this conservatively. Sixth Street CSA does not have adequate refrigeration for many shares to be held aside.* If you do not email, your share will be donated to our Community Fridge or Emergency Food Distribution Program. If you plan to be away for an extended period of time let us know if someone will be picking up in your place. Finally, please notify us if you decide to terminate or change your membership. We require at least 1 month's notice, otherwise you will be responsible for any fees.
